8:00 Start

Class A – OPEN CARD SCHOOLING 3'0"

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners. One round only per horse rider combination.

Class 1 - HUNTER OVER FENCES 3'0", OPEN

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners.

Class 2 – 3'0 EQUITATION MEDAL

To be judged over a course of minimum of 8 jumps including 1 combination, an oxer and a change of lead. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0". May also include in the course test(s) 1-8,10,13, or 14 from Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B. Those not eliminated in the over fences phase of this class will be asked to return to the ring for additional testing on the flat, where they will be tested at the walk, trot, and canter and may be asked to perform either individually or collectively any test or combination of tests 1-8, 10,13, 13 or 14 from the B.E.F. Rules Part II B

Tack and equipment must be in accordance with the BEF rules for equitation. Boots and bandages and standing martingales are permitted in the jumping phase, but must be removed prior to returning to the ring for the flat phase. Juniors may compete on horses or ponies. Distance changes may be made to any related distance on course where the related distance between the fences is less than 58' 0" to accommodate for juniors competing on ponies at the discretion of the judge and course designer. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 3 – 3'0 HUNTER U/S

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be asked for an extended trot. Horses/Ponies to stop easily, to back readily and stand quietly. Light contact with mouth is required. To be judged on performance and soundness.

BREAK – JUDGES COMMENTS & REVIEW (Mounted)

Class B – OPEN CARD SCHOOLING 3'6"

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 3'6". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners. One round only per horse rider combination.

Class 4 – OPEN HUNTER OVER FENCES 3'6"

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be judged over a minimum of eight fences and the height of fences will not exceed 3'6". Combinations on course will be adjusted for ponies if required. To be judged on performance, suitability and manners.

Class 5 – OPEN HUNTER OVER FENCES HANDY 3'6"

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. . To be judged over a minimum of eight fences and the height of fences will not exceed 3'6". Combinations on course will be adjusted for ponies if required. To be judged on performance, suitability and manners.

Class 6 - - 3'6 HUNTER U/S

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. To be judged on performance, soundness and manners.

BREAK – JUDGES COMMENTS & REVIEW (Mounted) – Ring Drag

Not before 11am:

Class C – OPEN CARD SCHOOLING 2'0"

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 2'0". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners. One round only per horse rider combination.

Class 7 - HUNTER OVER FENCES 2'0", OPEN

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 2'0". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners. Suitability of horse and rider will be considered.

Class 8 - EQUITATION O/F 2'0", OPEN

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. Height of fences not to exceed 2'0".

Class 9 – 2'0" EQUITATION, FLAT

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring. . Riders may be asked to perform any BEF test 1-3-4-5- 6-8-10 of the Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

BREAK – JUDGE'S COMMENTS & REVIEW (Mounted)**Class D – OPEN CARD SCHOOLING 2'6"**

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 2'6". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners. One round only per horse rider combination.

Class 10 - HUNTER OVER FENCES 2'6", OPEN

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences with no combinations on course. Height of fences not to exceed 2'6". To be judged on performance, suitability and manners.

Class 11 – 2'6 EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be judged over a course of minimum of 8 jumps including 1 combination, an oxer and a change of lead. Height of fences not to exceed 2'6. May also include in the course test(s) 1-8,10,13, or

14 from Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B. Those not eliminated in the over fences phase of this class will be asked to return to the ring for additional testing on the flat, where they will be tested at the walk, trot, and canter and may be asked to perform either individually or collectively any test or combination of tests 1-8, 10,13, 13 or 14 from the B.E.F. Rules Part II B

Tack and equipment must be in accordance with the BEF rules for equitation. Boots and bandages and standing martingales are permitted in the jumping phase, but must be removed prior to returning to the ring for the flat phase. Juniors may compete on horses or ponies. Distance changes may be made to any related distance on course where the related distance between the fences is less than 58' 0" to accommodate for juniors competing on ponies at the discretion of the judge and course designer. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 12 – 2'6 HUNTER U/S

Open to adults and juniors riding horses or juniors riding ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring. . Riders may be asked for an extended trot. Horses/Ponies to stop easily, to back readily and stand quietly. Light contact with mouth is required. To be judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized. Extreme speed is penalized.

SHOW RULES

1. – Correct money for each class must accompany entry form
2. – The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so
3. – **Dress:** Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in hunt cap with harness. Polo shirts may be worn, sleeveless shirts will not be accepted. Half chaps (black only) are acceptable. Jackets are not required. **Braiding** is completely optional.
4. – Any cruelty or abuse, whether physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person or official or the show, will result in immediate elimination by the show committee and may result in further disciplinary action taken by the Board of Directors of the Bermuda Equestrian Federation.
5. – No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse, either directly or indirectly *for example through the use of false ground lines or the jumping of offset oxers), will result in immediate elimination and may and may result in further disciplinary action taken by the Board of Directors of the Bermuda Equestrian Federation.
6. – Any situation or condition not covered by the rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Directors
