#### **RULES**

- 1. When entering this show, all horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members of, the BEF prior to the close of entries.
- 2. Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
- 3. The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- 4. Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in coat, hunt cap with harness. Refer to BEF Rule Book for further details on dress.
- 5. Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will result in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF Codes of Conduct in the BEF Rules.
- 6. Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- 7. No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- 8. Any situation or condition not covered by the rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Director.
- 9. All queries to be directed to the show secretary C: 505-3815 and E: jacherry@northrock.bm
- 10. To be eligible for a division championship, all classes of the division must be entered at the time of close of entries which in turn must be indicated on the Entry Form. Post entries will not be considered to division championships
- 11. Withdrawal of entries refer to BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.
- 12. List of requirements from which a judge may choose for an individual test in equitation classes may be found in the BEF Rule Book.
- 13. Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules, with exception of there being 3 refusals before elimination of rider. Seven minutes will be allowed for competitors to walk each jumping course.

# **PRIZE LIST**

- 1. Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place. A championship and reserve ribbon will be awarded for each division. Overall Junior and Senior Championship will be awarded based on points allocated to the rider.
- 2. Division Championships will be determined by the highest number of points awarded to a horse or rider as applicable.
- 3. Points will be awarded as follows:  $1^{st} 7$ ;  $2^{nd} 5$ ;  $3^{rd} 4$ ;  $4^{th} 3$ ;  $5^{th} 2$ ;  $6^{th} 1$ .

To be judged on performance and soundness and when indicated, conformation, suitability and manners. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0".

# Class 11a - #03 ADULT HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judges may ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight (8) will be asked to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability and manners.

# Class 2b - #04 JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES Class 2c - #04 JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES

To be judged on performance and soundness and when indicated, conformation, suitability and manners. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0".

# Class 2a - #04 JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge may ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability and manners.

# Class 15b - #12 ADULT EQUITATION OVER FENCES

One rider per mount. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0". To be shown over a course of not less than eight (8) obstacles. The course must include one combination which includes an oxer and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. To be judged over a course of not less than eight fences. Height of fences not to exceed 3'0". May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.

#### Class 15a - #12 ADULT EQUITATION

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to change mounts and/or to do an individual show. May be asked to perform Tests 1-18 of the B.E.F. Rules Part II. Two or more tests of the top four competitors is encouraged. **May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.** 

# Class 14b - #15 LOW HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES Class 14c - #15 LOW HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES

To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability and manners. Height of fences not to exceed 2'9". Courses may be ridden back to back. May not enter any other class of any other hunter division in a show where this class is offered.

#### Class 14a - #15 LOW HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive, and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability and manners. May not enter any other class of any other hunter division in this show.

# Class 19 - #01 RIDING HORSE 15.2hh & UNDER

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Horses to enter ring at walk. To be shown at a walk, trot, strong trot, canter and hand gallop. Only eight (8) horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance and manners.

# Class 20 - #02 RIDING HORSE OVER 15.2hh

To be judged as for Class 19.

SCHOOLING ROUND 2'3" – 2'6" Entries on the Field. Tickets to be purchased from the Announcer's Booth. @ \$10.00 per round. Two minutes allowed per rider. Can school with others at the same time i.e. 10 competitors will allow 45 minutes.

# Class 1b - #06 HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES Class 1c - #06 HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES

Ponies to be shown by junior competitors 18 years and under in all phases. Stallions are prohibited. To be shown over a minimum of eight fences the required height. Height of fences not to exceed 2'6". Judged on performance and soundness, manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized. Extreme speed is penalized. **May not enter any other class of any other hunter division in a show where this class is offered.** 

# Class 1a - #06 HUNTER PONY UNDER SADDLE

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be asked for an extended trot. Ponies to stop easily, to back readily and stand quietly. Light contact with the pony's mouth is required. To be judge on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized. Extreme speed is penalized. **May not enter any other class of any other hunter division in a show where this class is offered.** 

# Class 9b - #19 LOW HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES Class 9c - #19 LOW HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES

To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, manners & suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized over a minimum of eight (8) fences not to exceed 2'3". Extreme speed is penalized. Courses may be ridden back to back. May not enter any other class of any other hunter division in a show where this class is offered.

# Class 9a - #19 LOW HUNTER PONY UNDER SADDLE

To be shown at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be asked for a sitting trot and an extended trot. Ponies to stop easily, to back readily and stand quietly. Light contact with pony's mouth is required. To be judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized. Extreme speed is penalized. **May not enter any other class of any other hunter division in a show where this class is offered.** 

# Class 31b - X-RAILS HUNTER, UNDER 12 YEARS, OVER X-RAILS

To be shown over no more than eight x-rail fences. Judged on performance and soundness, manners and suitability of pony/horse to rider will be emphasized. Extreme speed is penalized.

# Class 31a - X-RAIL HUNTER, Under 12 years, UNDER SADDLE - Walk, Trot & Canter

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on performance and soundness, manners and suitability of pony/horse to rider will be emphasized

# Class 8 - #05 RIDING PONY UNDER SADDLE

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Ponies to be ridden by Junior competitors 18 years and under. Ponies to enter the ring at Walk. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance, manners and suitability.

# Class 7b - #11 JUNIOR EQUITATION 15-18 YEARS, OVER FENCES

One rider per mount. Competitors must have reached the required age grouping by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. Jumps cannot exceed 3' 0". The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability. *May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.* 

# Class 5b - #10 JUNIOR EQUITATION 12-14 YEARS OVER FENCES

One rider per mount. Competitors must have reached the required age grouping by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. Jumps cannot exceed 2' 9" and wings must be at least 30" wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability. **May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.** 

# Class 17b - #27 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION, 12 YEARS & UNDER, OVER FENCES

One rider per mount. Open to junior competitors who will not have reached their thirteenth birthday by September 1st of the current BEF season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be shown over a simple course of no more than eight fences not to exceed 2' 6" in height. . May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class in a show where this class or division is offered.

#### Class 6b - #09 JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER 12 YEARS. OVER FENCES

One rider per mount. Competitors must not have reached their twelfth (12) birthday by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. Jumps cannot exceed 2'3" and wings must be at least 30" wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability. May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division

#### Class 4b - WALK & TROT EQUITATION 10 YEARS & UNDER, OVER X-RAILS

One rider per mount. To be judged over a simple course of not more than eight fences, preference will be given to those competitors who illustrate their equitation at a <u>trot</u>. *May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division* 

#### Class 3 - #07 LEAD LINE EQUITATION UNDER 8 YEARS

Open to junior competitors who will not have reached their eighth (8) birthday by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. To be judged at a walk and trot only, with the ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. May be asked to perform Test 1 of the B.E.F. Equitation Rules Part II. Will not be asked to change mounts or do an individual show. **May not enter any other BEF equitation class.** 

#### Class 7a - #11 JUNIOR EQUITATION 15-18 YEARS

Only one rider per mount. To be judged at a walk, trot and center both ways of the ring. May be asked to perform Tests 1-18 of the BEF Rules.

# Class 5a - #10 JUNIOR EQUITATION 12-14 YEARS

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to do an individual show. May be asked to perform Tests 1-8, 10, 11, 13, or 14 of the B.E.F. Rules Part II. **May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.** 

#### Class 4a - #08 WALK & TROT EQUITATION 10 YEARS & UNDER

Competitors must not have reached their eleventh (11) birthday by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. To be judged at a walk and trot only. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. May be asked to perform Test 1 of the B.E.F. Equitation Rules Part II. May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.

#### Class 17a - #27 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION 12 YEARS & UNDER

To be judged at the Walk, Trot and Canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to perform tests 1,3,4,5,6,8,10 & 11 of the B.E.F. Rules Part II. **May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.** 

# Class 6a - #09 JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER 12 YEARS

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to perform B.E.F. Equitation Tests 1-3-4-5-6-8-10 of the B.E.F. Rules Part II. May not enter any other BEF designated equitation class of any other equitation division.

# Class 34 - HUNT CLUB HACK, HUNT CLUB MEMBERS ONLY

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Horses to enter ring at a walk. To be shown at a flatfooted walk with reasonably loose rein, trot, strong trot, easy canter and hand gallop. Only eight (8) horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, confirmation, substance and manners.

# Class 33 - HUNT CLUB OBSTACLE (2'3") CLASS, HUNT CLUB MEMBERS ONLY

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences not to exceed 3'0" in height. Handy Hunter requires an in and out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge takes into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round.

# Class 29 - PUDDLE JUMPER .070m - HORSES & PONIES USEF Optimum Time Competition

Height of fences not to exceed 0.70m. Optimum Time in First Round (Table IV Sec. 1) - The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum Time" (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

#### Class 28 - #PN1 PONY JUMPING

FEI Art. 238. 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 0.75m (2'6"). A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

# Class 23 - #PN2 PONY JUMPING

FEI Art. 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 0.85m (2'9"). A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

#### Class 24 - #H1 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 0.95m (3'1"). A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

# Class 26 - #H2 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.00m (3'3"). A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

#### Class 27 - #H3 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.10m (3'7") A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

# Class 30 - #H4 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.15m (3'9"). A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

# Class 32 - #H5 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m (3'11)). A competition against the clock, but in the event of the equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.
