Winner	<b>THE RICHFIELD TROPHY</b> – This trophy was donated by Harriet Richold in 2002 in honour of her horse Filthy Rich. This trophy to be awarded annually to the horse/pony rider combination gaining the most points in Dressage competitions with scores over 55%, jumping competition with BEF designators judged under Table A and Combined Training and/or Horse Trials. Winner	<b>THE JUDY MONTGOMERY MOORE MEMORIAL TROPHY</b> , Donated in 2012 by the Bermuda Dressage Group & the Bermuda Equestrian Federation, for the best combined score of horse/rider combination in the FEI World Dressage Challenge & the CEA Dressage Challenge in the Adult Division in the following tests Second Level and above and Medium Level and above. ANGELA HALLORAN-SMITH riding FINNOMINAL AV
Winner	<b>PEGASUS TROPHY</b> – This trophy was donated in 1990 by the Cherry Family for the Junior competitor gaining the most points when competing on ponies in BEF designated pony classes. Points designated by number of ponies entered at close of entries. NICHOLAS LOPES
Winner	<b>GRANTFIELD EPIC TROPHY</b> – Champion Pony Jumper – This trophy was donated by Mike and Roz Collins in 1992 for the pony gaining most points in show jumping. Points accumulated when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 6 <sup>th</sup> . SOUTHERN ECLIPSE owned by the Rego Family
Winner	<b>THE SKIPPY TROPHY</b> , for the pony with most points Overall – This trophy was donated in 2000 by Christy Holder in memory of her pony Skip On Doll. The trophy is for the pony registered with the BEF with the highest accumulative points, scored in any BEF designated class. Points accumulated when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> GEMINI owned by Jaden Johnston
Winner	<b>THE CHINA DOLL TROPHY</b> , for the junior with most points in Show Jumping same horse – This trophy was donated in 2007 by Heather McKirdy for the junior rider gaining the most points in show jumping riding the same horse. Points accumulated when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 6 <sup>th</sup> . KELSEY AMOS riding Wiratoro
Winner	<b>THE JENERATIONS DEBUT TROPHY</b> , for the Horse with most points - This trophy was donated in 2006 by Philip Correia and Margie and Dal Vasconcelos for the horse will the highest accumulative points scored in any BEF designated class. Points accumulated when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> DE LE VEGA owned by the Truran Family
Winner	<b>SHALIMAR TROPHY</b> – This trophy was donated in 1987 by Marina Curtis-Evans for the junior 14-18 years old riding the same horse in all competitions (In Hand classes do not count). Points accumulated when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 4 <sup>th</sup> only CASEY TRURAN and DE LE VEGA
Winner	<b>LITTLE ORVY TROPHY</b> – This trophy was donated by Carol Ann Blackman in 1982 in memory of her beloved horse, Little Orvy, who won virtually every major jumping event in Bermuda, having won some of them many times. It also honours his constant companion and friend, Annie, a Nubian goat who always came to shows with him, to the delight of spectators. Orvy was a true champion, always giving his best performance in every competition. It is therefore fitting that the Show Jumper of the Year be awarded this honour in his memory. It is meant to honour the Horse, who like Orvy, has been consistent in all endeavors. This trophy was originally presented at the Annual Mini Grand Prix DE LE VEGA owned by the Truran Family
Winner	<b>THE DECOSTA CONSTRUCTION LTD. TROPHY</b> , for the junior competitor with most points overall – Trophy donated in 2005 by Michael DeCosta CASEY TRURAN

Points to count only when ridden by a member of the Bermuda Equestrian Federation. Points count when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> place. <b>DE LE VEGA and CASEY TRURAN</b>
Winner	<b>COACHES AWARD</b> – Points accumulated from Junior Competitors when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> Donated in 1998 by the Cherry family for the Coach accumulating the most points with the results of his/her junior competitors in BEF designated classes. This trophy is also designed to promote membership in the Federation and the best qualified instructors to teach it's young people. All competitors must be members of the BEF and all coaches must be members also. <b>MICHAEL RODRIGUES</b>
Winner	<b>THE STABLE AWARD</b> – Points accumulated from all Competitors when placing from 1 <sup>st</sup> to 4 <sup>th</sup> Donated in 1998 by the Bermuda Equestrian Federation to promote membership in the Federation and enthusiasm amongst it's members. All horses and ponies must be registered with and all competitors must be members of the BEF. This trophy is awarded to the Stable whose members gain most points during the BEF Season. <b>INWOOD STABLES</b>
