## **RULES**

– When entering this show, all horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members of, the BEF prior to the close of entries.

– Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.

- The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.

– Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in coat, hunt cap with harness. Refer to BEF Rule Book for further details on dress.

- Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will result in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF Codes of Conduct

– Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.

– No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.

- Any situation or condition not covered by the rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Director.

- Withdrawal of entries refer to BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.
- Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. Seven minutes will be allowed for competitors to walk each jumping course.

### **PARTICIPATION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

- The BEF Support Jumper Show classes 1, 2 and 3 are only open to those competitors who will **not** reach their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday during 2019. Horse/rider combinations may only compete in either class 1, 2 or 3
- Classes 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8 are open to all competitors and for the purpose of BEF Championship the age will be that which appears in the BEF Rule Book for 2018 which is the age at 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018

### **ENTRIES**

- Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the BEF membership number of the rider. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.
- Post entries will be accepted prior to the start of a class as provided in the current BEF Rules
- The age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1, 2018. A junior competitor shall be under 18 years.

**FEES ENTRY FEES** - \$25.00 per class

**POST ENTRIES** – \$35

**ADMINISTRATION FEE:** \$25.00 for each horse/pony entered in the show

### **CLASS 1 - #H3 HORSE JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 1.10m. A competition against the clock. Competitors with equality of penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the schedule.

### **CLASS 2 - #H5 HORSE JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m. To be judged as for Class 1.

**CLASS 3 - #H6 HORSE JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 1.30m. To be judged as for Class 1.

**THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE OPEN TO ALL COMPETITORS:**

**CLASS 4—#H1 HORSE JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 0.95m. To be judged as for Class 1.

**CLASS 5- #H2 HORSE JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 1.00m. To be judged as for Class 1.

**CLASS 6 — #PN1 PONY JUMPING**

FEI Article 238.2.1. Height of fences not to exceed 0.75m. To be judged as for Class 1.

**CLASS 7 - #PN2 PONY JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1. Height of fences not to exceed 0.85m. To be judged as for Class 1.

**CLASS 8 - #P1 PONY JUMPING**

FEI Article 238 2.1. Height of fences not to exceed 0.95m. To be judged as for Class 1.
