Entries will be received preferably by email in a PDF file to BHPA@outlook.com, and pay online to the BHPA Account: Bank of N.T. Butterfield, Account Number 20-006-060-055546-100. Please **REMEMBER** to identify the entry you are paying for and put your **payment reference** where indicated on the entry form; OR May be left at Hinson Hall Stables, Inwood Stables or Breakaway Stables in a sealed envelope clearly marked **BHPA Entries**. Please make cheques payable to BHPA. (Avoid cash if possible). Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the BEF membership number of the rider. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.

REFUNDS - A 50% refund will be given upon receipt of a Dr.'s or Vet Certificate.
Post entries will be accepted prior to the first warning call for the particular class.

HORSE SHOW RULES

1. For BEF designated classes, all horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members of, the BEF prior to the close of entries. All queries regarding registration of horses &

memberships with the BEF are to be directed to Anne Cherry Tel: 505-3815 or email: jacherry@northrock.bm.

2. The age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1, 2018. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.
3. The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
4. Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in coat, hunt cap with harness. Refer to Rules of the BEF for further details on dress.
5. Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or show official, will result in immediate elimination of the entry concerned and possible reporting to the BEF as a breach of the BEF Code of Conduct.
6. No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
7. To be eligible for a division championship, all classes of the division must be indicated on the Entry Form and be entered at the time of close of entries.
8. Substitutions are allowed as follows: In equitation classes, where only the rider is judged, the mount may be changed up until the class is called. In all other classes, riders may be substituted without post entry charges. A new rider in an equitation class is a post entry; and a new horse/pony in any other class is a post entry. All requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.
9. List of requirements from which a judge may choose for an individual test in equitation classes may be found in the BEF Rule Book (last revised September 2018).
10. Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Director.
11. Hunter and Equitation classes will be judged under USEF Rules, as per the Rules of the BEF.
12. For further guidance please refer to the BEF website for the Rules of the BEF and the BEF Code of Conduct.

RIBBONS will be awarded to 6th place. POINTS for BEF Classes will be recorded to 10 places and submitted to the BEF.

An Overall BHPA Spring Show Champion and Reserve will be awarded to the Adult and Junior Riders who accumulate the most points over the two-day show.

To be eligible for Division Championships, you must enter all classes of the division as shown in the table above. Low Hunter Horses and Ponies may not enter any class of any other BEF Hunter Division. In Equitation Divisions, a rider may not enter more than one division.

The champion and reserve titles shall be awarded to two of the top four horses/ponies which have accumulated the most points performing over fences in the division in which they are being shown. Under saddle points will only be awarded to the top four horses placing in the over fences classes. The division championship will be determined by the highest number of points awarded to a horse/pony or rider as applicable. Division points will be awarded as follows: - 1st -7; 2nd-5; 3rd-4; 4th-3; 5th-2; 6th-1.

HUNTER CLASSES

BEF #03 ADULT HUNTER HORSE – Open to Horses ridden by Adults 19 years and over.

Class 3a – Adult Hunter over Fences 3’0”

Class 3b – Adult Hunter over Fences 3’0”

To be shown over a course of no less than eight fences not to exceed 3’0”. To be judged on performance, soundness, suitability and manners.

Class 3c – Adult Hunter Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse’s mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judges may ask participants to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight (8) will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability and manners.

BEF #04 JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE – Open to horses ridden by Juniors 18 years and under.

Class 4a. – Junior Hunter over Fences 3’0”

Class 4b. – Junior Hunter over Fences 3’0”

To be shown over a course of no less than eight fences not to exceed 3’0”. To be judged on performance, soundness, suitability and manners.

Class 4c. – Junior Hunter Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse’s mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judges may ask participants to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight (8) will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability and manners.

BEF #06 HUNTER PONY – Open to ponies ridden by junior 18 years and under in all phases. Stallions are prohibited. No cross entries with the Low Pony Hunter Classes.

Class 6a – Hunter Pony over Fences 2’6”

Class 6b – Hunter Pony over Fences 2’6”

To be shown over a course of no less than eight fences not to exceed 2’6”. To be judged on performance and soundness, and when indicated, conformation, suitability and manners.

Class 6c – Hunter Pony Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be asked for an extended trot. Ponies to stop easily, to back readily and stand quietly. Light contact with the pony’s mouth is required. To be judge on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized.

BEF #15 LOW HUNTER HORSE - Open to Horses ridden by adult or junior competitors, but may not enter any other BEF rated class of any other hunter division at this show.

Class 15a – Low Hunter Horse over Fences

Class 15b - Low Hunter Horse over Fences

Fences not to exceed 2’ 9”. To be judged on performance and soundness conformation, suitability and manners

Class 15c - Low Hunter Horse Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse’s mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors.

BEF #19 LOW HUNTER PONY - Open to ponies shown by junior competitors 18 years and under in all phases. Stallions are prohibited. Ponies may not enter any other BEF rated class of any other hunter division at this show.

Class 19a – Low Pony Hunter over Fences 2’3”

Class 19b – Low Pony Hunter over Fences 2’3”

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences not to exceed 2’3”. To be judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized. Extreme speed is penalized.

Class 19c – Low Pony Hunter Under Saddle

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may be asked for a sitting or

extended trot. Ponies to stop easily, to back readily and stand quietly. Light contact with the pony's mouth is required. To be judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of a pony to rider will be emphasized.

Class 36 –BHPA HUNTER PONY DERBY

SPECIAL ENTRY FEE \$100

Ponies to be ridden by Juniors. To be judged as class 37. Height of fences 2'3" with 3 option fences at 2'6". The top THREE placings will win a proportion of the purse as in class 37 as follows:

1^s – 45% 2nd – 25% 3RD – 20%

Class 37 – BHPA HUNTER DERBY CLASSIC

SPECIAL ENTRY FEE \$125

This is a competition for Prize Money open to horses only which may be ridden by adults or juniors. \$50 from each entry will go into the winnings purse. The top THREE placings will win a proportion of the purse as follows:

1^s – 45% 2nd – 25% 3RD – 20%

This is a 2-round HUNTER DERBY with fence heights set at 3' and 3 jump options set at 3'3" to 3'6". Entrants will receive one bonus point for each higher option taken. A maximum of 10 bonus points may be awarded by the judge for handiness in Round 2. Scores and bonus points will be announced separately in each round. Round 1 and 2 scores and bonus points will be added together with the highest score winning. In case of a ties in the overall placings, the Handy round score (Round 2) will break the tie. There will be no jump off. Horses will not be required to jog for soundness. Any unsoundness will be reflected in the score from the judge. Normal Hunting attire is required; formal hunter dress encouraged.

Round 1 – Hunter Classic Course

A classic hunter course consisting of a minimum of 8 fences/obstacles that simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and a variety of derby jumps will be used. To be judged on performance hunter pace and style, quality and substance, movement and brilliance.

Round 2 – Handy Hunter Course

Course will consist of a minimum of 7 obstacles set at 3' with a minimum of 2 "handy options". A maximum of 10 bonus points may be awarded for handiness. To be judged on style, brilliance and handiness.

EQUITATION CLASSES

BEF #07 JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER 8 YEARS (LEAD LINE). Open to Junior competitors who must not have reached their eighth (8) birthday by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. To be judged at a walk and trot only, with the ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Only one rider per mount to be shown on the Lead Line. Stallions are prohibited. May be asked to perform Test 1 of the Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

Class 7a – Lead Line Equitation
Class 7b – Lead Line Equitation

BEF #08 JUNIOR EQUITATION 10 YEARS & UNDER (WALK AND TROT). Open to Junior competitors who must not have reached their eleventh (11) birthday by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. To be judged at a walk and trot only. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Only one rider per mount to shown on the flat. Stallions are prohibited. May be asked to perform Test 1 Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

Class 8a – Walk and Trot Equitation
Class 8b – Walk and Trot Equitation

BEF #09 JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER 12 YEARS. - Open to Junior competitors who must not have reached their twelfth (12) birthday by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. One rider per mount over fences and/or on the flat. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 9a. - Junior Equitation under 12 years, over Fences

Jumps cannot exceed 2’3” and wings must be at least 30” wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability.

Class 9b. - Junior Equitation under 12 years, Flat

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to perform Tests 1-3-4-5-6-8-10 of the Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

BEF #27 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION 12 YEARS & UNDER - Open to Junior competitors who must not have reached their thirteenth birthday by September 1st of the current BEF Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine is acceptable. Only one rider per mount over fences and/or on the flat. Stallions are prohibited. May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class in a show where this class or division is offered.

Class 27a – Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences

To be shown over a simple course of no more than eight fences not to exceed 2’6” .

Class 27b – Short Stirrup Equitation Flat

To be judged at the Walk, Trot and Canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to perform tests 1,3,4,5,6,8,10 & 11 Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

BEF #10 JUNIOR EQUITATION 12 TO 14 YEARS - Open to Junior competitors who must have reached the required age grouping by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Only one rider per mount over fences and/or on the flat. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 10a. - Junior Equitation 12-14 years, over Fences

Jumps cannot exceed 2' 9" and wings must be at least 30" wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability.

Class 10b. - Junior Equitation 12-14 years, Flat

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to do an individual show. May be asked to perform Tests 1-8, 10, 11, 13, or 14 Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

BEF #11 JUNIOR EQUITATION 15 TO 18 YEARS - Open to Junior competitors who must have reached the required age grouping by September 1st of the current B.E.F. Show Season. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Only one rider per mount over fences and/or on the flat. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 11a. - Junior Equitation 15-18 years, over Fences

Jumps cannot exceed 3'0". The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability.

Class 11b. - Junior Equitation 15-18 years, Flat

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to change mounts and/or to do an individual show. May be asked to perform Tests 1-18 Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B.

BEF #12 ADULT EQUITATION - Open to adults 19 years or older. Only one rider per mount over fences and/or flat.

Class 12a. Adult Equitation over Fences

Height of fences not to exceed 3'0". To be shown over a course of not less than eight (8) obstacles. The course must include one combination which includes an oxer and two changes of direction after the first obstacle.

Class 12b. Adult Equitation, Flat

To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries may be asked to change mounts and/or to do an individual show. May be asked to perform Tests 1-18 Equitation Tests found in the B.E.F. Rules Part II B. Two or more tests of the top four competitors is encouraged.

Class 30 – ADULT LEADLINE

To be judged at a walk and trot only, with the ability of the rider only to be judged. Stallions are prohibited. Will not be asked to change mounts or do an individual show.

Class 31 – X-RAILS EQUITATION OPEN

To be judged at the walk and trot only. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability. (Please note that this class is open to all ages but only the points for juniors aged 10 years and under at 1st September, 2018 are considered for the separate overall Walk Trot Championship with classes 8a and 8b).

Class 32 – 2’0” EQUITATION OPEN

To be judged at the walk, trot and canter. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability.

Class 33 – 2’3” EQUITATION OPEN

To be judged at the walk, trot and canter. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability.

Class 34 – MAKE YOUR OWN LINE (2’6 & 3’0)

Competitors will be required to design their own **equitation** course consisting of 8 – 10 obstacles. All jumps must be jumped in the correct direction. The course should include two (2) changes of direction, one (1) jump then halt, 1 sitting trot over the x-rail and must finish with a complete dismount to exit the ring. Blank course forms will be provided and must be handed in by 12:00pm for the judge’s review. Please indicate your desired height on the entry form.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Class 1 – BEF #01 RIDING HORSE 15.2hh and UNDER.

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Horses to enter ring at walk. To be shown at a walk, trot, strong trot, canter and hand gallop. Only eight (8) horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance and manners.

Class 2 – BEF #02 RIDING HORSE OVER 15.2hh.

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Horses to enter ring at walk. To be shown at a walk, trot, strong trot, canter and hand gallop. Only eight (8) horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance and manners.

Class 5 – BEF #05 RIDING PONY.

Ponies to be ridden by junior competitors 18 years and under. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance, manners and suitability.
