RULES

• – When entering this show, all horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members of, the BEF prior to the close of entries.

• - Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.

• - The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.

• – Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in coat, hunt cap with harness. Refer to BEF Rule Book for further details on dress.

• - Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will result in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF Codes of Conduct http://www.bef.bm/bef%20codes%20of%20conduct/codeofconductspage.htm

• – Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.

• – No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.

- – Any situation or condition not covered by the rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Director.

• – Withdrawal of entries refer to BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.

• – Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. Seven minutes will be allowed for competitors to walk each jumping course.

ENTRIES

• – Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the BEF membership number of the rider. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.

• - Post entries will be accepted prior to the start of a class as provided in the current BEF Rules

• - The age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1, 2018. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

FEES ENTRY FEES - \$25.00 per class POST ENTRIES – \$35 ADMINISTRATION FEE: \$25.00 for each horse/pony entered in the show SCHOOLING: Main Ring \$10.00 per horse per round. Schooling Entries may be paid for <u>in advance</u> with your entries and indicated on the entry form or on the Field. For those not paying in advance tickets must be purchased from Announcers Booth prior to schooling.

FEI Article 238 2.2 Height of fences not to exceed 0.95m. This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

CLASS 2- #H2 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2 Height of fences not to exceed 1.00m. To be judged as for Class 1.

CLASS 3 - #H3 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.10m. To be judged as for Class 1.

CLASS 4 - #H4 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.15m. To be judged as for Class 1.

CLASS 5 - #H5 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.2 Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m. To be judged as for Class 1.

Class S2 - SCHOOLING ROUND x-rails & 2'. Entries in advance or on the Field. On the Field tickets to be purchased from the Announcer's Booth. @ \$10.00 per round. Two minutes allowed per rider. Can school with others at the same time i.e. 10 competitors will allow 20 minutes.

CLASS 6-HORSES and PONIES

USEF Optimum Time Competition

Height of fences not to exceed X-RAILS. Optimum Time in First Round (Table IV Sec. 1) Optimum Time in First Round (Table IV Sec. 1) – This competition is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum Time" (defined as 4 seconds less than the

Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

CLASS 14-#H1 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 0.95m. A competition against the clock. Competitors with equality of penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the schedule.

CLASS 15- #H2 HORSE JUMPING

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 1.00m. To be judged as for Class 14.

FEI Article 238 2.1 Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m. To be judged as for Class 14.

CLASS S4 - SCHOOLING ROUND x-rails & 2'. Entries in advance or on the Field. On the Field tickets to be purchased from the Announcer's Booth. @ \$10.00 per round. Two minutes allowed per rider. Can school with others at the same time i.e. 10 competitors will allow 20 minutes.

CLASS 19-HORSES and PONIES

USEF Optimum Time Competition – X-RAILS

Height of fences not to exceed X-RAILS. CLASS 25 - #PN2 PONY JUMPING
