Emails will be time stamped in case COVID restrictions require that we limit entries or NEC Entry Passes. Please complete the COVID Tracing document with each entry.

HORSE SHOW COVID POLICY

The BEF COVID Policy MUST be adhered to. Entry to the NEC will be limited to 75 people and allowed only to those with an entry pass. Entry passes can be shared if contact information for each used is provided to the Show Committee. Entry Passes will be allocated as follows

- a. Horse show officials and (pre-Arranged) volunteers
- b. Riders (plus an adult for junior riders)
- c. Coaches (with a rider competing)
- d. Grooms (one pass per horse entered)
- e. At close of entries, extra entry passes will be allocated by the Show Committee.

All entry passes will be recorded with contact information for attendee tracing if necessary.

Masks must be worn in any ring (if not mounted on a horse) and whenever social distancing of at least six (6) feet cannot be maintained.

Only seven (7) riders are allowed in any ring at a time with one (1) groom/coach each. Priority in the warm-up will be given to the next seven horses in the Order of Go. Riders and grooms are asked to stand/walk their horses outside the rings if not actively warming up. Only entered riders and coaches are allowed on the course walk.

Entry passes and rider packs will be available for pick up on Thursday night, 5:30-7:30, at the course build at NEC. Rider packs will include schedules, entry passes, and any show updates.

Please respect the rules of COVID safety for yourself and your community. We have been given the opportunity to horse show again in Bermuda so let's keep this privilege!

BEF SUPPORT SHOW RULES

- 1. When entering this show, all horses & ponies must be registered with the BEF and competitors must be members of the BEF prior to the close of entries.
- 2. Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
- 3. The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- 4. Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will results in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF codes of Conduct.
- 5. Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- 6. No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- 7. Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Directors and the Organizing Committee.

- 9. For withdrawal of entries, refer to the BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be direct to the Show Secretary.
- 10. Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. FEI Dress will be required.

PRIZE LIST: Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

- **1. ENTRIES**: Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the rider's BEF membership. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.
- **2. AGE OF JUNIOR:** The Age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1st 2020. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

ENTRY FEES - \$25.00 per class - POST ENTRIES - \$40

SCHOOLING - \$10.00 per horse per round. Must be included with entry fees.

SHOW SCHEDULE FOR BEF SUPPORT JUMPER SHOW

To commence immediately following the CEA RJC Prize Presentation at approximately 12 noon.

Class S1 - Schooling Round

Schooling will be set at 1.0m. Two minutes will be allowed per rider. Riders may school over any fence that is flagged in the correct direction, there is no set course. Schooling must be indicated on the entry form with payment of \$10 per round included with entry.

Class 4 - #H3 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.1m (3' 7"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Class 5 - #H5 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.2m (3' 11"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Class 6 - #H6 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.3m (4' 3"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.
