

**Self-Attestation**  
**Updated on 22nd December 2021**

Please complete this self-attestation of your negative Antigen Test status in the event you wish to enter the National Equestrian Centre (NEC) as a competitor (rider or driver) or coach. The Antigen test must be taken the day of the event.

Per the Return to Sport Guidelines, in order to enter the NEC as a competitor/coach, you are required to (i) complete an Antigen Rapid Test the **day of the event/competition**, (ii) attest that you have a negative result, or (iii) or are in possession of a valid SafeKey. Junior competitors can show proof of 7-day SafeKey as issued by the Ministry of Health.

**If you are a Spectator, you must have a SafeKey as a result of a PCR test or vaccination certificate and confirmation of an Antigen test taken the day of the event. Complete the attestation form. This information will be verified at the entry gate.**

Access to this data will be limited to the Executive of the Event Organising Committee.
