BEF SUPPORT SHOW RULES

- When entering this show, all horses & ponies must be registered with the BEF and competitors must be members of the BEF prior to the close of entries.
- · Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or
 official of the show, will results in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF
 codes of Conduct.
- Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Directors and the Organizing Committee.

- For withdrawal of entries, refer to the BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be direct to the Show Secretary.
- Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. FEI Dress will be required.

DRESS & SADDLERY: Please refer to the FEI Jumping Rules for all rules on saddlery. FEI Dress will be required. Approved headgear must be worn.

PRIZE LIST: Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place

ENTRIES: Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the rider's BEF membership. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.

AGE OF JUNIOR: The Age of a junior competitor will be taken as of 1st September 2022. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

SHOW SCHEDULE FOR BEF SUPPORT JUMPER SHOW

To commence immediately following the CEA RJC Prize Presentation at approximately 12 noon.

Class S1 – Schooling Round

Schooling will be set at 0.95m (3'1"). Two minutes will be allowed per rider. Riders may school over any fence that is flagged in the correct direction, there is no set course. Schooling must be indicated on the entry form with payment of \$20.00 per round included with entry.

Class 1 - #H2 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.00m (3' 3"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Class 2 - #H3 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.10m (3' 7"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Class 3 - #H5 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.20m (3' 11"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.

Class 4 - #H6 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238.2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.30m (4' 3"). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round.
