BEF SUPPORT SHOW RULES

- 1. When entering this show, all horses & ponies must be registered with the BEF and competitors must be members of the BEF prior to the close of entries.
- 2. Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
- 3. The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- 4. Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will results in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF codes of Conduct.
- 5. Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- 6. No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- 7. Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Directors and the Organizing Committee.
- 8. For withdrawal of entries, refer to the BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.
- 9. Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. FEI Dress will be required.

PRIZE LIST: Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

- **1. ENTRIES**: Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the rider's BEF membership. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.
- 2. AGE OF JUNIOR: The Age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1st 2022. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

SHOW SCHEDULE FOR BEF SUPPORT JUMPER SHOW

Class 1 - Puddle Jumper, Horses & Ponies Height of fences 0.70m

MODIFIED FEI ARTICLE 238.2.1. Athletes with equality of penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round versus the optimum time as per Equestrian Canada Article G613. In the event of equality of penalties and time, the tie will stand and the tied athletes will be placed equally for that place. No jump-off will take place.

EC ARTICLE G613 MATCH THE CLOCK (OPTIMUM TIME) COMPETITION

i. Match the clock or optimum time classes are designed to help developing riders learn the skill of riding a course at the posted speed, rather than with the fastest time. Competitors with equal faults will be placed according to how close their time is to the optimum time, which is based on the course being ridden at the posted speed.

Class 2 - Puddle Jumper, Horses & Ponies Height of fences 0.80m

MODIFIED FEI ARTICLE 238.2.1. To be judged as for Class 1

Class 3 - Horse Jumping

FEI Art 238 2.2. Height of fences 0.85m (2'9") This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round. For minor Competitions (see GRs) the jump-off may be run according to table C, if thus provided in the Schedule

Class 4- #H1 Horse Jumping

FEI Art 273 3.3.2 Height of fences 0.95 (3'1") Competition over Two Rounds. The first round is run under Table A, Not against the clock and the second round is run under Table A, Against the Clock. The final score for each athlete is the total faults of the two rounds plus the time in the second round. In the event of equality of penalties and time, the tie will stand and the tied athletes will be placed equally for that place. No jump-off will take place.

Class 5 - #H2 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238 2.1. Height of fences not to exceed 1.00m (3' 3"). Athletes with equality of Penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of Penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule.

Class 6 - #H3 Horse Jumping

FEI Art 238 2.2. Height of fences not to exceed 1.1m (3'7). This is a Competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of Penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other Athletes are placed according to their Penalties and time in the first round. For minor Competitions (see GRs) the jump-off may be run according to table C, if thus provided in the Schedule

Class 7 - #H5 Horse Jumping

FEI Article 238 2.1. Height of fences not to exceed 1.2m (3' 11").c Athletes with equality of Penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of Penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule.
