RULES

1. For classes, all horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members of, the BEF prior to the close of entries
2. Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
3. The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries if they have reason to do so.
4. Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in coat, hunt cap with harness. Refer to BEF Rule Book for further details on dress.
5. Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will result in immediate elimination by the organizing committee. Refer to BEF Codes of Conduct.
6. Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction of the Collecting Ring Steward.
7. No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
8. Any situation or condition not covered by the rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Director.

10. Withdrawal of entries refer to BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.
11. List of requirements from which a judge may choose for an individual test in equitation classes may be found in the BEF Rule Book.

PRIZE LIST

- Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place at each show.
- Points will be awarded as follows: 1st –7; 2nd –5; 3rd –4; 4th –3; 5th –2; 6th –1.

ENTRIES

- Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the BEF membership number of the rider. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.
- Post entries will be accepted prior to the start of a class as provided in the BEF Rules.
- The age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1, 2023. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

BEF DIVISIONS ARE NOW BASED ON A RANGE OF HEIGHTS. Horse shows can offer any height(s) they choose for their prize list and the heights will determine which BEF division the class accumulates points for. The comparable “height” will also determine divisions for under saddle (flat classes). For example, a show can offer a 0.75m (2’6”) class as well as a 0.85m (2’9”) class and both classes will count towards the division for 0.70m-0.85m.

A rider or horse/rider may choose a different over fences height than their under saddle (flat class) “height” but the points in each class will earn towards different divisions for year-end awards. For example, a rider may choose to equitate at 0.70m (2’4”) over fences but enter the 1.0m (3’3”) flat class (the lower division is intended for newer, less experienced riders but an experienced rider may simply be more comfortable at the height over fence and wish to compete in a tougher class on the flat.

For fairness of play, each equitation rider can only compete at one height (or mixed height) at each horse show.

SCHOOLING A – HEIGHT OF FENCES BETWEEN 0.70M – 0.85M

Payment in advance or at the Canteen on the day for \$20 per round.

9 am START

CLASS 1A – JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES OVER 0.70M AND UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M (HUH03)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.70m and not to exceed 0.85M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 1B – JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE HANDY OVER FENCES OVER 0.70M AND UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M (HUH03)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences over 0.70M in height and not to exceed 0.85M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 29A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 1C JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE (HUH03)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 2A – ADULT HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES OVER 0.70M AND UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M (HUH07)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.70m and not to exceed 0.85M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability

CLASS 2B – ADULT HUNTER HORSE HANDY OVER FENCES OVER 0.70M AND UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M (HUH07)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences with a minimum height of 0.70M and will not to exceed 0.85M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 30A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 2C – ADULT HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE (HUH07)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 3A – JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M (HUH04)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.85m. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 3B – JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE HANDY OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M (HUH04)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences with a minimum height of 0.85M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 29A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 3C – JUNIOR HUNTR HOSE UNDER SADDLE (HUH04)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 4A – ADULT HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M (HUH08)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.85m. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 4B – ADULT HUNTER HORSE HANDY OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M (HUH08)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences with a minimum height of 0.85M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 29A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 4C – ADULT HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE (HUH08)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 29– RIDING HORSE 15.2 HH AND UNDER (#01)

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Horses to enter ring at walk. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop. Only eight (8) horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance and manners.

CLASS 30 – RIDING HORSE OVER 15.2HH (#02)

Judged same as class

SCHOOLING B – BETWEEN 0.06M AND 0.07M

Payment in advance or at the Canteen on the day of for \$20 per round.

CLASS 5A – HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES OVER 0.60M, UPTO AND INCLUDING 0.70M (HUP02)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.60m and not to exceed 0.70M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 5B – HUNTER HANDY PONY OVER FENCES OVER 0.60M, UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.70M (HUP02)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences with a minimum height of 0.60M and not to exceed 0.70M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 34A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, *maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will* also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 5C – HUNTER PONY UNDER SADDLE (HUP02)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 6A – HUNTER PONY OVER FENCES OVER 0.70M (HUP03)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.70m and not to exceed 0.80M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 6B – HUNTER HANDY PONY OVER FENCES OVER 0.70M (HUP03)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences over 0.70M in height and not to exceed 0.80m. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 28A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, *maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will* also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 6C – HUNTER PONY UNDER SADDLE (HUP03)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 7A –JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES OVER 0.60M, UPTO AND INCLUDING 0.70M (HUH02)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.60m and not to exceed 0.70M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 7B – JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE HANDY OVER FENCES OVER 0.60M, UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.70M (HUH02)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences with a minimum height of 0.60M and not to exceed 0.70M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 37A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, *maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will* also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLAS 7C – JUNIOR HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE (HUH02)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 8A –ADULT HUNTER HORSE OVER FENCES OVER 0.60M, UPTO AND INCLUDING 0.70M (HUH06)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences with a minimum height of 0.60m and not to exceed 0.70M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 8B – ADULT HUNTER HORSE HANDY OVER FENCES OVER 0.60M, UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.70M (HUH06)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences with a minimum height of 0.60M and not to exceed 0.70M in height. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 37A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, *maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will* also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 8C – ADULT HUNTER HORSE UNDER SADDLE (HUH06)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

SCHOOLING C – HEIGHT BETWEEN XRAILS AND UP TO 0.60M

Payment in advance or at the Canteen on the day of for \$20 per round.

CLASS 9A – HUNTER PONY OVER XRAILS AND UP TO 0.60M (HUP01)

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences over xrails and up to 0.60M. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and suitability.

CLASS 9B – HUNTER HANDY PONY OVER XRAILS AND UP TO 0.60M (HUP01)

To be ridden over a course of jumps to consist of no less than 8 fences over xrails and up to 0.60M. Handy Hunter will be judged as per class 33A, but the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence and at least 2 changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, *maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that the judge will* also take into consideration when awarding a score. Scores will be announced on completion of each round

CLASS 9C – HUNTER PONY UNDER SADDLE (HUP01)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, and responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judge *may* ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring. No more than eight will be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, soundness, conformation, suitability, and manners.

CLASS 31 – RIDING PONY (#05)

Entries to be shown under English saddle. Ponies to be ridden by junior competitors 18 years and under. Ponies to enter ring at walk. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance, conformation, substance, manners and suitability.

SCHOOLING D – UP TO 0.60M

Payment in advance or at the Canteen on the day of for \$20 per round.

CLASS 10 – EQUITATION OVER 0.60M UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.70M OVER FENCES (EQJ03)

JUNIORS ONLY: Jumps cannot exceed 0.70m and wings must be at least 30" wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability. Stallions are prohibited to be ridden by juniors. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation over fences class at this show.**

CLASS 11 – EQUITATION OVER 0.60M UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.70M OVER FENCES (EQA03)

ADULTS ONLY: Jumps cannot exceed 0.70m and wings must be at least 30” wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation over fences class at this show.**

CLASS 12 – JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE. May be asked to perform BEF Equitation Tests 1, 3-6, 8,10. of the BEF Rules Part III. **(EQJ03)**

The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be judged at a walk, Trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class under saddle (flat class).**

CLASS 13 – ADULT EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE. May be asked to perform BEF Equitation Tests 1, 3-6, 8,10. of the BEF Rules Part III. **(EQA03)**

The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be judged at a walk, Trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class under saddle (flat class).**

CLASS 14: EQUITATION OVER 0.60M UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.70M OVER FENCES MEDAL (EQJ03 & EQA03) *Note: Juniors and Adults will be announced separately but class placing will be on an “open” basis*

To be judged seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. To be shown over a minimum of eight fences over 0.60M up to and including 0.70M, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the over fences, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

All riders are to return for the flat phase where competitors may be required to perform test(s) from the BEF Rules as provided for in the Under Saddle section of the EQJ03 & EQA03. The flat performance of those riders shall count 50%. Changing of bit/bridle between phases is permissible. Only riders competing in both phases are eligible for placing. Only one rider per horse.

CLASS 15 – EQUITATION OVER 0.70M UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M OVER FENCES (EQJ04)

JUNIORS ONLY: Jumps cannot exceed .85M and wings must be at least 30” wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability. Stallions are prohibited to be ridden by juniors. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class over fences at this show.**

CLASS 16 – EQUITATION OVER 0.70M UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M OVER FENCES (EQA04)

ADULTS ONLY: Jumps cannot exceed .85M and wings must be at least 30” wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class over fences at this show.**

CLASS 17 – JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE. May be asked to perform BEF Equitation Tests 1-8, 10, 11, 13, 14 of the BEF Rules Part III **(EQJ04)**

The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be judged at a walk, Trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class under saddle (flat) class.**

CLASS 18 – ADULT EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE. May be asked to perform BEF Equitation Tests 1-8, 10, 11, 13, 14 of the BEF Rules Part III **(EQA04)**

The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be judged at a walk, Trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class under saddle (flat) class.**

CLASS 19: EQUITATION OVER 0.70M UP TO AND INCLUDING 0.85M OVER FENCES MEDAL (EQJ04 & EQA04) *Note: Juniors and Adults will be announced separately but class placing will be on an “open” basis*

To be judged seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. To be shown over a minimum of eight fences over 0.70M up to and including 0.85m in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the over fences, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

All riders are to return for the flat phase where competitors may be required to perform test(s) from the BEF Rules as provided for in the Under Saddle section of EQJ04 & EQA04. The flat performance of those riders shall count 50%. Changing of bit/bridle between phases is permissible. Only riders competing in both phases are eligible for placing. Only one rider per horse.

CLASS 20 – EQUITATION OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M (EQJ05)

JUNIORS ONLY: Jumps must exceed 0.85M and wings must be at least 30” wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider’s ability. Stallions are prohibited to be ridden by juniors. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation over fence class at this.**

CLASS 21 – EQUITATION OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M (EQA05)

ADULTS ONLY: Jumps must exceed 0.85M and wings must be at least 30" wide. The performance begins when the horse enters the ring. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability. **May not enter any other BEF rated fence class at this.**

CLASS 22 – JUNIOR EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE. May be asked to perform BEF Equitation Tests 1-18 of the BEF Rules Part III **(EQJ05)**

The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be judged at a walk, Trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class under saddle (flat) class.**

CLASS 23 – ADULT EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE. May be asked to perform BEF Equitation Tests 1-18 of the BEF Rules Part III **(EQA05)**

The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. To be judged at a walk, Trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class under saddle (flat) class.**

CLASS 24: EQUITATION OVER FENCES OVER 0.85M MEDAL (EQJ05 & EQA05).

Note: Juniors and Adults will be announced separately but class placing will be on an "open" basis

To be judged seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. To be shown over a minimum of eight fences over 0.85M in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the over fences, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

All riders are to return for the flat phase where competitors may be required to perform test(s) from the BEF Rules as provided for in the Under Saddle section of EQJ05 & EQA05. The flat performance of those riders shall count 50%. Changing of bit/bridle between phases is permissible. Only riders competing in both phases are eligible for placing. Only one rider per horse.

SCHOOLING E – COMBINATION OF POLES & XRAILS

Payment in advance or at the Canteen on the day for \$20 per round.

CLASS 25 – LEAD LINE EQUITATION Over Poles (EQJ01)

JUNIORS ONLY. To be ridden over a course off jumps to consist of no more than 8 fences not to exceed pole in height. To be judged at a walk and trot only, with the ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and can perform required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class at this show.**

CLASS 26 – WALK & TROT EQUITATION Over XRails (EQJ02)

JUNIORS ONLY. To be judged at a walk and trot only. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and can perform required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited.

May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class.

May be asked to perform Test 1 of the BEF Equitation Rules Part III. **May not enter any other BEF rated equitation class at this show.**

CLASS 28 – WALK & TROT EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE (EQJ02)

JUNIORS ONLY: To be judged at a walk and trot only. The ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and can perform required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. May be asked to perform Test 1 of the B.E.F.
