BEF SUPPORT SHOW RULES

- The Support Show will be run under BEF Rules. Click here to access the current rules.
- When entering this show, all horses & ponies must be registered with the BEF and competitors must be members of the BEF prior to the close of entries.
- Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or
 official of the show, will results in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF
 codes of Conduct.
- Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Directors and the Organizing Committee.
- For withdrawal of entries, refer to the BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be direct to the Show Secretary.
- Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. Seven minutes will be allowed for competitors to walk each jumping course.

DRESS & SADDLERY: Please refer to the FEI Jumping Rules for all rules on saddlery. Properly fitting and fastened headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. Rules of dress require light colored breeches or jodphurs with boots. Show shirts or collared shirts or polo shirts are allowed if they are white, buttoned up, and tucked in with a belt. Jackets should be available but can be waived on the day of the show by the Ground Jury.

PRIZE LIST: Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

ENTRIES: Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the rider's BEF membership. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.

Post entries will be accepted prior to the start of a class.

AGE OF JUNIOR: The Age of a junior competitor will be taken as of 1st September 2024. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

SHOW SCHEDULE FOR BEF SUPPORT JUMPER SHOW

To commence immediately following the CEA Prize Presentation

Schooling 0.75m - 0.85m

Payment in advance or on the field. \$20 per round.

Class 1 (BEF: JP04) – Horse/Pony Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 0.85m USEF Optimum Time Competition - Optimum Time in Frist Round (Table IV Sec. 1) – This competition is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum Time" (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

Class 2 (BEF: JP05) - Horse Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 0.95m

USEF Optimum Time Competition - Optimum Time in Frist Round (Table IV Sec. 1) – This competition is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum Time" (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

Class 3 (BEF: JP06) – Horse Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 1.05m FEI Article 238.2.1. This is a Competition against the clock. Athletes with equality of Penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of Penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course of obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule.

Class 4 (BEF: JP07) – Horse Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 1.15m FEI Article 238.2.1. To be judged as for Class 3.

Class 5 (BEF: JP08) – Horse Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 1.25m FEI Article 238.2.1. To be judged as for Class 3.
