# **ENTRY FEES** - \$20.00 per class - **POST ENTRIES** – \$40 **ADMINISTRATION/JUMP FEE** = \$30.00 for each horse/pony entered in the show. (Not applicable if horse/pony is already entered in the CEA Show)

## **BEF SUPPORT SHOW RULES**

- The Support Show will be run under BEF Rules. <u>Click here</u> to access the current rules.
- When entering this show, all horses & ponies must be registered with the BEF and competitors must be members of the BEF prior to the close of entries.
- Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will results in immediate elimination by the show committee. Refer to BEF codes of Conduct.
- Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Directors and the Organizing Committee.
- For withdrawal of entries, refer to the BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be direct to the Show Secretary.
- Jumping classes will be held under FEI Rules. Seven minutes will be allowed for competitors to walk each jumping course.

**DRESS & SADDLERY:** Please refer to the FEI Jumping Rules for all rules on saddlery. Properly fitting and fastened headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. Rules of dress require light colored breeches or jodphurs with boots. Show shirts or collared shirts or polo shirts are allowed if they are white, buttoned up, and tucked in with a belt. Jackets should be available but can be waived on the day of the show by the Ground Jury.

PRIZE LIST: Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

**ENTRIES**: Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the rider's BEF membership. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted.

Post entries will be accepted prior to the start of a class.

**AGE OF JUNIOR:** The Age of a junior competitor will be taken as of 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

# SHOW SCHEDULE FOR BEF SUPPORT JUMPER SHOW

## To commence immediately following the CEA Prize Presentation

#### Class 1 (BEF: JP07) – Horse Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 1.15m

FEI Article 273.3.3.2. To be judged as for RJC. Competition over Two Rounds. The first round is run under Table A, not against the clock and the second round is run under Table A, against the clock (Reverse order of penalties in the first round; athletes retain their drawn order in case of equality of penalties). The final score for each athlete is the total faults of the two rounds plus the time in the second round. In the event of equality of penalties and time, the tie will stand, and the tied athletes will be placed equally for the place. No jump-off will take place.

## Class 2 (BEF: JP08) – Horse Jumping Height of fences not to exceed 1.25m

FEI Article 273.3.3.2. To be judged as for Class 1.
